This list is not to be considered exhaustive, yet a sampling of serious offenses that will result in action by the Board of Directors. The Board will also make reference to the NAHCR Code of Conduct Policy.

Rules of Conduct

- 1) Excessive use of email/phone/postal mail etc. to solicit active member business.
- 2) Use of offensive, threatening or otherwise inappropriate language.
- 3) Engaging in disruptive, discourteous, unprofessional or illegal conduct.
- 4) Inappropriate or unauthorized use or reference to the NAHCR brand or its' Board of Directors.
